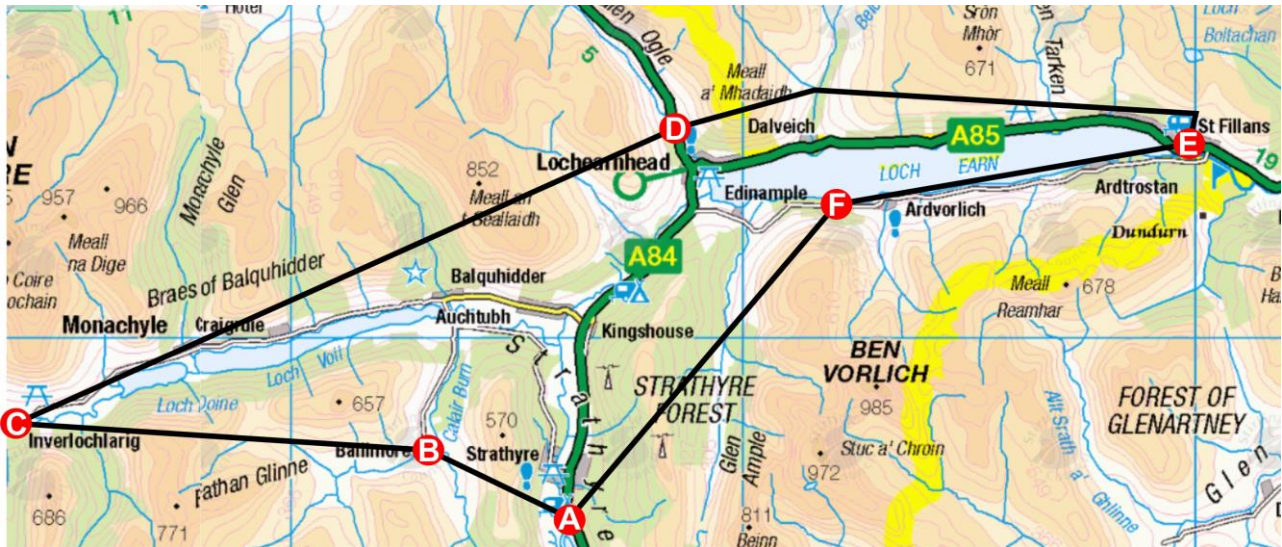


Balquhider DRT Service (DRT 2): extended area from 18th December 2018



This Scheme covers adopted publicly-maintained roads wholly within the area bounded by:

- A - A84 immediately south of Immervoulin Caravan Park access road;
- B - end of public road at Ballimore, south of Balquhider;
- C - end of public road at Inverlochlarig, west of Balquhider;
- D - A85 at north end of Lochearnhead 30 mph area;
- E - A85 in St Fillans, immediately west of junction with South Loch Earn Road;
- F - Council boundary on South Loch Earn Road east of Edinample.

All journeys must start or finish within the Stirling Council area.

Balquhider DRT will be available on Mondays to Sundays between 07:00 and 22:00.
No service on 25-26 December or 01-02 January in any year.

This service is operated by Crescent Cabs and Kingshouse Travel Ltd on behalf of Stirling Council.

Once registration is set up, customers can then manage their bookings 24/7. Bookings can also be made up to 2 hours prior to the required journey time, however all journeys are subject to availability and the more notice that can be given, the greater the likelihood a journey can be fulfilled by the operator.

Telephone Bookings: Can be made on Mondays to Fridays 09:00-15:00, except 25-26 December and 01-02 January in any year. Bookings for Tuesdays to Saturdays must be made by 15:00 on the previous day. Bookings for Mondays must be made by 15:00 on the previous Friday.

Scottish National Entitlement Cards are accepted as on bus services.
