

## Carron Valley DRT Service (DRT 7): from from 18th December 2018



Journeys may be made between any two points on the following roads (shown above in red):

- B818 between Craignannet and Carron Bridge Hotel;
- Unclassified road between Carron Bridge Hotel and Stirling via Loch Coulter and Howietoun Fishery;
- Unclassified road between Loch Coulter Burn and Stirling via North Third Reservoir and Chartershall;
- Unclassified road between Howlands and Foot o' Green;
- Unclassified road via Cauldbarns and Craignend;
- Unclassified road between Cauldbarns/Craignend and Auchebowie West.
- Unclassified road between Craignend and Cangloar/Myres.

Journeys may also be made between any point on the roads listed above and:

- St Ninians Health Centre;
- Stirling Community Hospital;
- Stirling City Centre; or
- Springkerse Retail Park.


'Stirling City Centre' is defined as any publically-maintained road shown on the map on the following page.

Carron Valley DRT will be available on Mondays to Fridays within the following time slots:

09:15 - 10:30, 13:45-15:00, 17:15-18:30

Journeys must be completed with one time slot. For example, on a journey within the 13:45-15:00 time slot must be booked such that the passenger will board the vehicle no earlier than 13:45 and alight from the vehicle no later than 15:00.

No service on 25-26 December or 01-02 January in any year.

**Online Bookings:** Please register an account at <https://trapezoweb.stirling.gov.uk/Account/Login> Once registration is set up, customers can then manage their bookings 24/7. Bookings can also be made up to 2 hours prior to the required journey time, however all journeys are subject to availability and the more notice that can be given, the greater the likelihood a journey can be fulfilled by the operator.

**Telephone Bookings:** Can be made on Mondays to Fridays 09:00-15:00, except 25-26 December and 01-02 January in any year. Bookings for Tuesdays to Saturdays must be made by 15:00 on the previous day. Bookings for Mondays must be made by 15:00 on the previous Friday.

Scottish National Entitlement Cards are accepted as on bus services.
