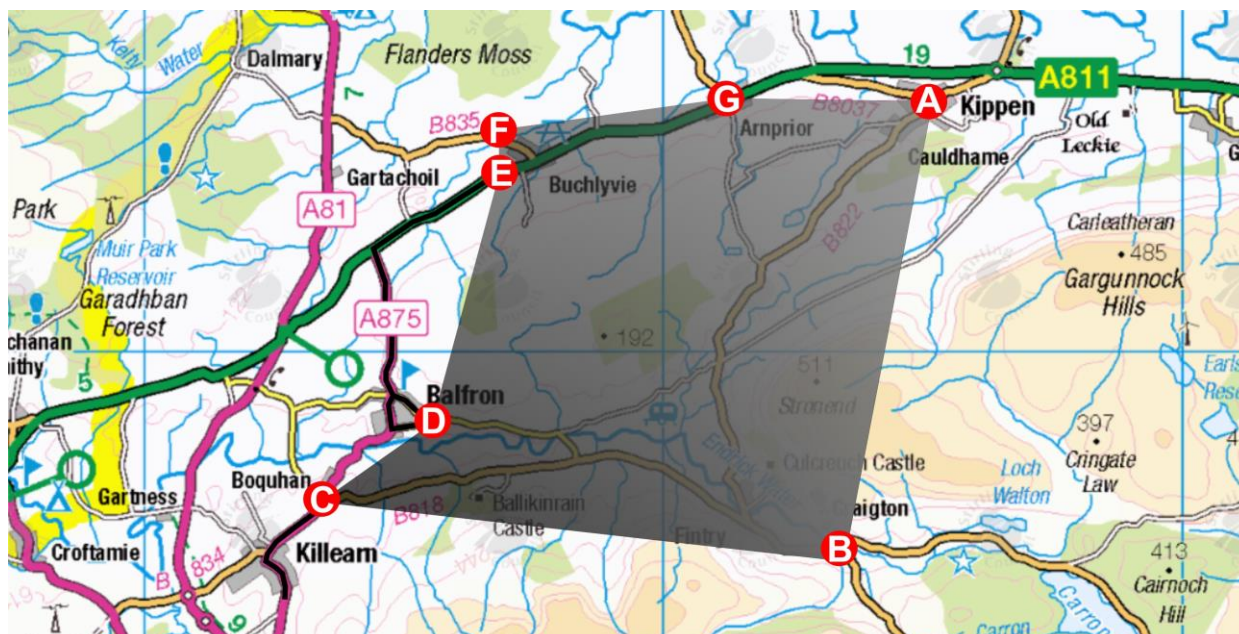


Fintry DRT Service (DRT 4): extended area from from 18th December 2018

This Scheme covers adopted publicly-maintained roads wholly within the area bounded by:

- A - Kippen Cross bus stops, Kippen;
- B - Junction of B818 and B822 at Gonachan
- C - Junction of A875 and B818 at Blackhills Crossroads;
- D - Junction of Dunmore Street and Roman Road, Balfron;
- E - A811 at west end of Buchlyvie 30 mph area;
- F - B835 at north end of Buchlyvie 30 mph area;
- G - Arnprior bus stop on A811.

Note: through journeys can be made to adjoining DRT areas.

Journeys may also be made between points within this area and all bus stops and customary bus stopping places on the following roads, shown in black on the map above:

Balfron: between Dunmore Street/Roman Road junction, Buchanan Street Bus Stops (at/opposite Co-op and at/opposite Clinic) and Balfron High School;

Killearn: between A875/B818 junction at Blackhills Crossroads and Killearn (at/opposite Co-op).

Buchlyvie - Balfron (Saturdays only, 07:00-09:30): between A811 at west end of Buchlyvie 30 mph area and bus stops in Buchanan Street, Balfron, at/opposite Health Centre.

Fintry DRT will be available on Mondays to Saturdays between 07:00 and 21:30 (excluding Buchlyvie - Balfron extension, which is available only on Saturdays, between 07:00 and 09:30).

No service on 25-26 December or 01-02 January in any year. This service is operated on behalf of Stirling Council. Scottish National Entitlement Cards are accepted as on bus services.

Online Bookings: Please register an account at <https://trapezeweb.stirling.gov.uk/Account/Login> Once registration is set up, customers can then manage their bookings 24/7. Bookings can also be made up to 2 hours prior to the required journey time, however all journeys are subject to

availability and the more notice that can be given, the greater the likelihood a journey can be fulfilled by the operator.

Telephone Bookings: Can be made on Mondays to Fridays 09:00-15:00, except 25-26 December and 01-02 January in any year. Bookings for Tuesdays to Saturdays must be made by 15:00 on the previous day. Bookings for Mondays must be made by 15:00 on the previous Friday.

Scottish National Entitlement Cards are accepted as on bus services.
